She has held various leadership positions such as Global Head of Corporate, Investment and Private Banking IT at HSBC Global Technology Centres, MD at Merrill Lynch India Technology Services across India, Singapore, Ireland and Canada, and as Asia CIO for Global Markets and Research technology at Bank of America Merrill Lynch. At BBVA, Harmeem was the CIO for Global Markets and Risk and Operations for Corporate and Investment Banking and led large-scale business and IT transformation programs across Europe, US and Latin America.

Harmeem is currently a member of the Cyber Security Taskforce at NASSCOM, India's leading industry association for IT sector. She has been recognized by Economic Times as top 10 women in the telecom and tech industry across the globe.
